His current primary focus is on helping healthcare organizations become compliant with healthcare regulations, in particular HIPAA, and move toward e-health. He also provides high-level regulatory compliance security assessments for SOX and GLBA-affected clients as well as information management services aimed at business process improvement, business intelligence, and decision support.

As the former Director of Enterprise Standards for the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA), he was responsible for agency-wide information systems policy, system security, and Paperwork Reduction Act activities. He was also the chairman of the government-wide HIPAA Administrative Simplification Security and Electronic Signature Standards Implementation Team and was closely involved in the development of national policy for electronic health care information security and privacy.

A frequent speaker at various national conferences on HIPAA security and healthcare data security and privacy on the Internet, John has over 35 years experience in information systems management in both the public and private sectors. He holds a B.E.S. in Industrial Engineering and Operations Research from Johns Hopkins University and a M.S. in Management Science and Operations Research from George Washington University.
